8.00am – 9.15am	Welcome, Settling in time.
9.15am – 9.30am	Mat Time (following the children's interests)
9.30am – 10.00am	Kai Time
10.00am – 11.30am	Programme Activities, Outside Play, Planned activities that follow children's interests
11.30am – 12.00pm	Kai Time
12.00pm – 2.15pm	Programme Activities, Outside Play, Planned activities that follow children's interests
2.15pm – 2.30pm	Mat Time (following the children's interests)
2.30pm - 3.00pm	Kai Time
3.00pm - 3.45pm	Activity set up to support interests.
3.45pm – 5.30pm	Free Play and Clean up



Children's care routine (Kai, Bottles, nappy changes and sleeping) will always come first.



There will be Mat Times during the day that include and support children's interests.



Tamariki/children have opportunities for exploration in both indoor and outdoor environments on a daily basis.



Opportunities for tamariki/children to experience art, music, physical activity and sensory play will be provided daily in a way that support children's holistic development.

PUKEKO ROOM DAILY PROGRAMME

Time	Activities
8.00—9.00	Children are welcomed on arrival, and are settled in. Teachers communicate with parents about their child.
9.00-9.45	Programme activities, Free play, curriculum work and excursions to the farm (Library, Lister home, St Pats).
9.45-10.00	Morning mat time. (Welcome song, Days of the week, months of the year, what day and date it is, Weather), Karakia is sung.
10.00-10.15	Morning Kai
10.00-11.45	Programme activities, Free play, curriculum work and excursions.
11.45-12.00	Music/Mat time (action songs and music and movement), Karakia is sung
12.00-12.30	Lunch/Kai time
12.30—2.15	Programme activities, Free play, curriculum work and excursions.
2.15—2.45	Work Time, split into age groups for an in-depth learning session (Science,Literacy,Maths)
2.45—3.00	Afternoon mat time, a storey board stories, and Ka Kite, followed by the Karakia
3.00—3.15	Afternoon Kai time
3.15—3.30	Tidy up time,
3.30—5.30	Free Play, Tidy up time

If your child needs to sleep we will support their needs, by giving them the choice to sleep on the couch in the Pukeko Room or to go in to the Kiwi Room on a stretcher.
